LAST MEETING: Club Speaker, Hugh Pattison continued his previous address telling us about his 10-year association with Swedish company, Husqvarna. It is 336 years old, and started producing rifles in 1689. The factory was built by a waterfall which was the source of the power. In 1872 they started making sewing machines. Later they built a foundry to make kitchen items, then made bicycles, and in 1903 started making motorcycles. In 1919 Husqvarna made their first lawn mowers, and 1959 they started making chainsaws. Electrolux purchased the appliance side of the Company, but Husqvarna split from Electrolux in 2006. The company now makes demolition robots, robot mowers, and since it joined with Gardena in 2016, started producing automatic watering systems.

<u>Guest Speaker: Phillipa Pilcher, Macular Degeneration NZ</u>, a registered charity. MDNZ aims to raise awareness and provide education. It receives no Government funds.

MD affects progressive central vision. 1 in 7 over 50 yrs will have MD, and 1 in 4 over 80 yrs. You have a 50% chance if it is in your family history. There are wet and dry types of MD. Symptoms include blurred vision. It is important to use the Amsler Grid to check your sight. Delayed treatment = delayed vision. Prompt diagnosis is important.

Treatment- Wet = injections in the eye,

Dry = improved lighting, and medication.
